BUMC Annual Charge Conference

4:30 PM, November 9 at Susanna Wesley UMC

A "charge" refers to the appointment of a pastor to a church or ministry setting. The term has historical roots in the early Methodist movement, when local societies met in homes or shared spaces rather than dedicated church buildings. John Wesley appointed preachers to take "charge" of these societies—a term that endures today. A charge now refers to any church or entity to which a United Methodist pastor is appointed. Berryton UMC is part of a Two-Point Charge with Shawnee Heights UMC.

A charge conference is an annual meeting of the leadership of a pastoral charge, held to make key decisions on behalf of the congregations. The meeting is presided over by the district superintendent. Voting members of the charge conference include all clergy appointed to the charge and members of the church councils. (Retired clergy and retired diaconal ministers who hold membership in any of the congregations are also members of the conference.)

BUMC conference's responsibilities include the following:

- Reviewing and evaluating the overall mission and ministries of the charge
- Approving lay leadership positions for the upcoming year
- · Adopting a budget for all congregations within the charge
- Setting salaries and compensation for the pastor
- Reviewing annual membership records for each congregation




Calling all woodworkers, crafters, artists, creative folks, oh and YES, Pie makers!
